Dr. Tonny Kidega is a young Christian Ugandan Veterinarian. He worked in the big game parks of Uganda where he specialized in Chimpanzees. He then was hired by Heifer International to oversee their Dairy Cow Program. One of his duties was to train farmers how to care for their cows.



He has since visited the US and spent a month at Country Dairy in Michigan learning new and modern

ways of feeding and caring for dairy cows. Now, he's back in Gulu, Uganda to help construct and then

manage the new proposed Research Dairy facility.

CURRENTLY, Dr. Tonny is coordinating the clearing of the land, which should be happening any day. Also, he's researching and lining up the well drilling, along with the water tank that we estimate will have to be 16 to 20 feet high. There's much research and coordination to be done there, and we're so thankful to have Tonny as part of the team!
